2026 Long Island USBC Fall Classic Rules

General Rules:

1. All bowlers must be sanctioned through either Long Island USBC, New York City USBC or Staten Island USBC.
2. All bowlers will use their highest **composite** average, with a minimum of 54 games, listed for either the 2024-2025 and 2025-2026 seasons as listed on Bowl.com. If a league is listed on a Bowl.com without an average reported, the bowler is responsible for reporting the average to the tournament chairperson.
3. Lanes will be re-oiled between squads.
4. Tournament chairperson has the right to adjust scores after bowling is completed, should a verified average or other pertinent information becomes available that was not known at the time of entry.
5. Individual bowlers must declare if they are listed on any published average rerate list, or if any other tournament or association has rerated their average.
6. If a bowler has no average they will bowl scratch, no handicap pins will be allowed.
7. Every entrant has the responsibility to know they are competing at the correct average; all team captains will sign an acknowledgement on their score sheets. Any discrepancies will result in average adjustments and score changes, flagrant violations will result in disqualification.
8. Tournament chairperson will reserve all rights to re-rates, adjustments, rule interpretations and disqualifications.
9. Tournament entries close once practice is completed. No more entries will be accepted for that squad.

Playing Rules:

1. Each team will consist of 4 bowlers.
2. Bowlers will receive 90% of 240 for handicap purposes. No negative pins will be given for bowlers entering above 240.
3. Teams will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes.
4. Teams may re-enter with the same lineup.
5. Champions will be determined by total pinfall, including handicap.
6. In the event of a tie for any position in the standings, all prizes will be split equally.

Entry Fees: The entry fee is \$280 per team. There will be a discounted entry fee for teams that signup, with full team information, prior to established deadlines. Discounted team entry fee will be \$240. Breakdown fee for \$240 is broken down as follows: \$60 Lineage, \$40 expenses (**\$2/entry will be donated to USBC Bowl for the Cure**), \$140 prize fund. Prize Fund will be returned 100%, with a cashing ratio of 1 in 5. Payment can be made by using the QR Code on the front of the flyer, mailing entry to the office or using the link below:

Optional Events:

There will be optional singles and doubles events held in conjunction with this event. Handicap and scratch singles event will have an entry fee of \$20 per division. The doubles event will also be \$20 optional doubles scratch and handicap event as well, bowlers may bowl doubles with any other bowler in their squad, limited to 5 partners per squad. Long Island USBC will take 7% of total fees collected per event for expenses.

Financials: The tournament chairperson will provide prize fund, financials and oversee the issuance of prize fund checks within 14 days of the end of the tournament, pending average and sanction verification.
